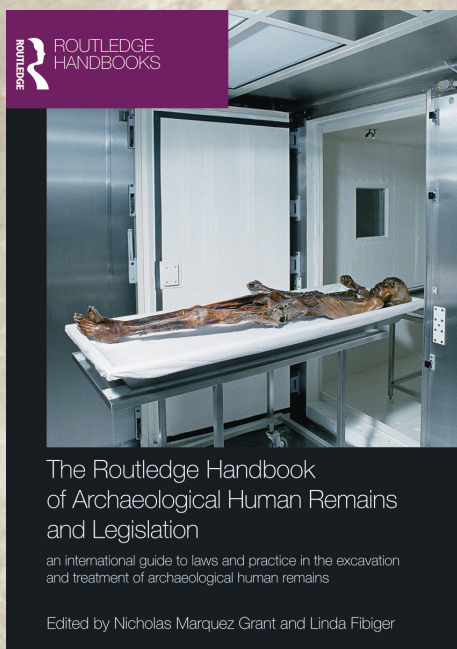

Any specific legislation regarding human remains from churchyards and those from recent war graves?
- Are physical anthropologists involved in the excavation process?
- What methods of anthropological analysis are mostly used in the country? Are there any population specific methods created in the country?
- Are there particular ethical issues that need to be considered when excavating human remains, such as religious groups or tribal groups?
